Primary Orientation

The Association Montessori Internationale (AMI) was founded by Dr. Montessori and her son, Mario in 1929. For more than 95 years AMI has been the leading organization for the Montessori Educational approach.

The Primary Orientation Certification is an introduction and orientation to Dr. Montessori's educational pedagogy and practice to support the development of the child from 2,5-6 years.

This course is designed for educators, parents, caregivers, administrators, classroom assistants and anyone who is interested in human development during the child's most formative and creative period of life.

The course will highlight Montessori philosophy as well as offer practical guidelines on how to support the child's developing potentials at home and in the classroom.

The course is 60 hours online with 25 hours synchronous and 35 hours asynchronous. Attendance is 90% for the Synchronous aspect of the course.

During the synchronous sessions (there are 10) there will be lectures relevant to the topic of the session. These sessions will be on a zoom platform and the link will be shared a day before the beginning of the course. The same link will be used for all the ten sessions. The link also be available on the learning platform.

For the 35 hours of asynchronous time, we will use is the Google Classroom which is user friendly and easy to navigate. There will select readings, discussions and videos for you.
